# MISSIONS <br> JANUARY MISSION FOCUS Building a Grandmother's House In memory of Trae Gilbert-DeGraffe 

During December, we gave almost $\$ 2400$ toward the $\$ 3000$ needed for our church to finance the building of a "Grandmother's House" in Kenya. Grandmothers who are extremely poor "inherit" their grandchildren when the parents die of AIDS. They and the children struggle in many ways, living in rundown shacks.
The Maua Methodist Hospital organizes and oversees the building of small homes ( $\$ 3000$ each), and when completed, each new home is dedicated in the name of the church that provided the funding or to a person that the church selects. Our December and January gifts will finance the building of a Grandmother's House, and our Missions Committee is hoping to dedicate the house in the name of Trae Gilbert-DeGraffe, our young member who died on November 8, 2023, the grandson of Bob and Angie Edwards.

If you can help, please make checks payable to CUMC, designated "Grandmother's House," or drop coins into the loose change jug on Sundays.
